

## CONFIDENTIAL MEETING SUMMARY

The Center for Substance Abuse Treatment National Advisory Council (CSAT NAC) met in closed session to review summary statements for applications received in response to CSAT's FY 2001 funding announcements that were scored by initial review groups (IRGs). This was the 30<sup>th</sup> meeting of the CSAT NAC.

**Federal Staff Attendees:** Dr. Westley Clark, CSAT Director, chaired the meeting. Mr. George Gilbert, Acting Deputy Director, and Ms. Cynthia Graham assisted. CSAT program and policy staff and SAMHSA review and grants management staff were represented.

**Council Member Attendees:** Andrea Amprey, Andrea Barthwell, Louis Baxter, Martin Iguchi, Lisa Mojer-Torres, Mayra Rodriguez-Howard, Pamela Thurman, Hershell Warren, and Connie Weisner. [Peter Edelman and Hope Taft were unable to attend.]

Dr. Clark opened the meeting with a roll call of NAC members and self introductions by Federal staff attendees. He thanked the Council members for their assistance with the important grant application review process. Ms. Cynthia Graham summarized the role of Council members in the review process and explained the confidentiality and conflict of interest (COI) requirements. She instructed the members to return or shred the summary statements they had reviewed and explained that they needed to send her their conflict of interest statements, but that mail ballots would not be required because individual votes would be recorded.

The following grant/cooperative agreement programs were reviewed. The NAC's recommendation on each bloc of applications under the program is provided.

### **(1) RFA TI 05-003 - "TCE "**

- ▶ summary statements were reviewed
- ▶ Barthwell was recused because of a potential COI
- ▶ members did not need to discuss the bloc or an individual summary statement
- ▶ all members present concurred with the IRG's recommendations

### **(2) RFA TI 05-00 – "family and Juvenile Treatment Drug Courts"**

- ▶ 20 summary statements were reviewed
- ▶ Myra Rodriguez-Howard was recused because of a potential COI
- ▶ members did not need to discuss the bloc or an individual summary statement
- ▶ all members present concurred with the IRG's recommendations

Dr. Clark closed the meeting by thanking the NAC members for their participation. He said he would see them at the upcoming September 14-15, 2005, Council meeting.
