Summary

- After the implementation of the revised Guidelines on 1 October there were:
 - A reduction in the number of specimens tested (5.4%)
 - An increase in the percent of specimens reported as Drug Positive

Summary (continued)

- The major drugs responsible for the increase in the percent of specimens reported positive were those whose cutoffs were lowered:
 - Cocaine
 - Amphetamine
 - Methamphetamine
- Smaller increases were observed in 6-AM and codeine
