


# Kentucky: Tying the Communities and State together using the SPF SIG Process

- ❖ State Agencies are linked to SPF through local affiliates
- ❖ Community Project Coordinators
- ❖ Master Trainers (Regional Prevention Centers)
- ❖ Quarterly reports and Site visits
- ❖ Bi-annual meetings of all granted counties
- ❖ TA is just a phone call away


# Funding Streams

- Federal Block Grant
  - Prevention Enhancement Sites (3)
  - Regional Prevention Centers (14)
- SPF SIG
  - State
  - County (8)
  - Proposed Mini Grants for 20 additional Counties to improve readiness and conduct needs assessment
- State General Fund
- Tobacco Settlement Funds
  - 9 communities funded to improve readiness and conduct needs assessment
- Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities Funding
  - Early Intervention Program
